



2 Days Safari – Lake Manyara /Tarangire National Park & Ngorongoro Crater

Tour Summary:

- This tour starts and ends in Zanzibar.
- **Activities:** Game drives
- **Departure/ Arrival:** From Zanzibar between 07:00 - 07:45, arrival time in Arusha at 09:00 – 09:30.
- **Departure/arrival:** From Arusha/KIA between 16:30 – 19:00, arrival time in Zanzibar at 18:00 – 20:30.
- **Can start any day** - If availability permits, this tour can start on any day.

Itinerary

Day 1: Arusha to Lake Manyara / Tarangire National Park

Morning flight from Zanzibar to Arusha; upon arrival at Arusha airport, meet your driver and drive to Tarangire/ Lake Manyara National Park with packed lunch for game viewing; later, drive back to the lodge for dinner and overnight.

Tarangire is excellent and has a diverse ecosystem, boasting one of the largest concentrations of elephants in East Africa. The park is almost 3000 sq km and is best known for its many elephants and baobab trees. The park's name comes from the Tarangire River, which crosses through the park.

Lake Manyara National Park is one of the Rift Valley's most renowned lakes and home to impressive concentrations of birds and large mammals. Even though the park is small, 325 sq. kilometres, it has awe-inspiring scenery and is well-known for its growing population of baboons, tree-climbing lions and elephants.

Day 2: Ngorongoro crater – Arusha/Zanzibar

After breakfast, you will descend over 600 meters into the crater for a full-day crater tour with a picnic lunch. The crater supports various animals, including herds of wildebeests, zebras, buffalos, elands, warthogs, hippos, giant African elephants, lions, hyenas, jackals, cheetahs and leopards. Later in the afternoon, drive to Arusha Airport or Kilimanjaro International Airport for your flight back to Zanzibar.

The Ngorongoro Conservation Area is a pioneering experiment where people (the Maasai), livestock, and wildlife co-exist and share the same protected habitat. The stunning spectacle of the Ngorongoro Crater, its steep walls falling some 610 meters to the floor, is undoubtedly one of the highlights of a safari tour in Tanzania.

The crater floor is home to thousands of everyday animals, including the rare black rhinos, zebras, wildebeests, gazelles, hippos, elands, elephants, and a large predator population of lions, hyenas, and jackals. It's also famous for its giant elephants globally and has massive tusks.
